

## GUIDELINES FOR PRESENTATIONS

### **e –Poster Presentation Restricted to 30 nos. only**

#### **The instruction for e-poster presentation includes:**

1. Abstract shall include the author names and affiliations, brief introduction, objectives, methodologies, results and significant findings with e-mail id of corresponding author.
2. Abstract should not be more than 250 words, typed in Times New Roman, title 14, font size 12, in single space.
3. Summary shall include introduction, objectives, methodologies and results in the form of tables, graphs and significant findings with essential references. Summary should not contain the author names and affiliations.
4. The time allotted for each e-poster presentation is **FIVE MINUTES** (Four minutes for presentation and One minute for discussion).
5. e-poster should be prepared as a single PowerPoint slide in PDF format; additional slides are not accepted for the same poster.
6. The PowerPoint slide should be legible and readable from a distance of about 15 feet.
7. Abstract and title should be submitted on or before 04.03.2020.
8. Maximum number of e-posters accepted will be 30 in total.

### **Oral Presentation Restricted to 07 nos. only**

#### **Guidelines for the oral paper presentation:**

1. The time allotted for each e-poster presentation is **FIVE MINUTES** (Four minutes for presentation and One minute for discussion).
2. The oral PowerPoint presentation may consist of 10-12 slides in PDF format.
3. The PowerPoint slide should be legible and readable from a distance of about 15 feet.
4. Presentations should be prepared in the widescreen format with a ratio of 16:9.
5. Images, Figures, Video and Audio will be preferred more over Text in PPT.
6. Abstract and title should be submitted on or before 04.03.2020.
7. Maximum number of Oral presentations accepted will be 7 nos. in Total.
